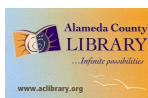

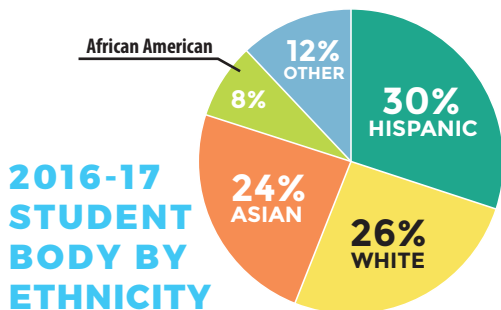

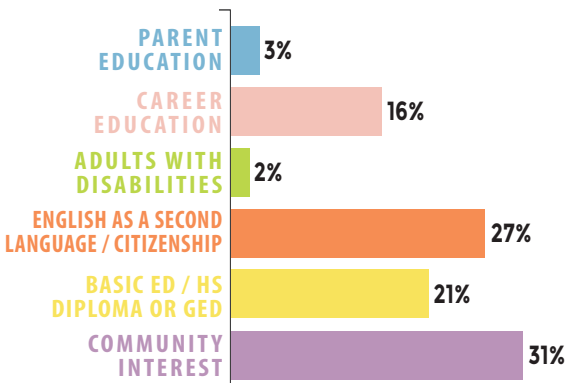

classes help adults improve their English listening, speaking, reading and writing skills.

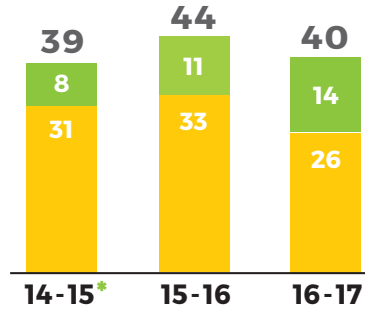
ADULT SECONDARY EDUCATION (ASE)
