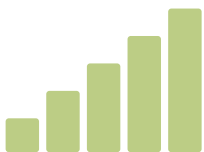

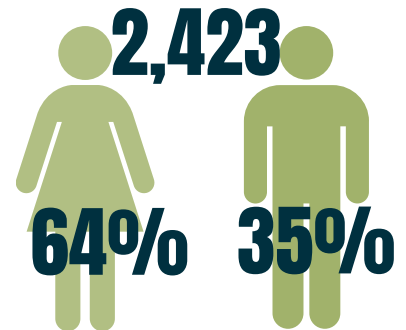

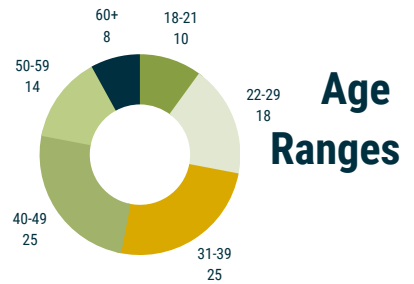
Our Mission is to provide adult learners educational opportunities and services, promote transitional readiness, and prepare each individual to become a productive member of the community.
