Donald A. McCune Collaborative Award**

This award honors the memory of Donald A. McCune who was Director of the Adult, Alternative, and Continuing Education Division of the State Department of Education, when he was killed while piloting his own plane in 1986. As an administrator, educator, and advocate for adult programs, he received numerous honors and awards. He served as the CCAE Board Liaison from the SDE and was selected by President Reagan to serve on the Training Committee of the White House Conference on Productivity. He was also a member of the Board of the American Association of Adult and Continuing Education. He held a doctoral degree from Stanford University and authored a number of national publications in the field of adult literacy.

Eligibility: The nominee must have, for five years or more, established collaborative arrangements among agencies to enhance services to the adult learner. Membership in CCAE of at least three years, including the current year, is required. Letters of endorsement from collaborative agencies must be included.
